Deadline: September 14th, 2022. Approved abstracts will be selected for either oral presentation or poster presentation. Feedback will be given by email in late September 2022.

The abstracts, posters, and oral presentations will be delivered in English. The abstract must not exceed 300 words and should be structured: Background, Methods, Results, Discussion, and Conclusion. Please state the primary affiliation of each co-author and note the presenting speaker with *.
